CLUE 3

1. Now start at **WS**, from where you finished the cast off of the clue 2, as following: s11pw, k to the end.
 2. Next row: s11pw, k 2, *k and k to back of the same stitch (here is a [video](#))*; repeat * to * at 84 times, k 3. Now you have 176 stitches on your needle. If you have some more or less stitches you can increase or decrease them during the next row to get the desired 176 stitches.
 3. Next row (**WS**): s11pw, k 2, p 170, k 3.
 4. Next row: s11pw, k 2, start with chart 3a 1st row, knit it 17 times totally, k 3. Go on with chart 3a.
- WS** rows are like in the first clue: s11pw, k 2, p until 3 stitches remain, k 3.
 Repeat chart 3a rows 1-12 two more times.

After you finished row 36 go on with chart 3b. On rows 49-59 pattern between black lines are repeated 17 times and after that, before edge stitches, knit left part of chart.

At the end of row 60 (**WS**) you should have 211 stitches on your needles.

- Row 61: s11pw, k to the end;
 Row 62 (**WS**): s11pw, k to the end;

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Row 63: sl1pw, k 2; [(yo, k 1) 8 times, (yo, k2tog) 2 times], the part between [] have to be knitted 17 times; yo, k2tog, k 2. Now you should have 347 stitches on your needles.

Row 64 (**WS**): sl1pw, k 346.
